TREX PLASTIC RECYCLING

Plymouth Presbyterian Church is collection items that can be recycled by Trex. Please bring your acceptable recyclables to Fellowship Hall and deposit in indicated containers.

Clean all back of food and debris before depositing in the bins.

When you are sorting through your plastics after the holidays, please refer to these reminders about what does or does not go into the Trex recycled plastic bin. Checking this list, and checking it twice, will be a big help in processing the recyclable plastic.

Acceptable bags:

- produce bags
- store bags,
- ice bags,
- Ziploc & other reclosable bags
- cereal box liners
- case overwrap
- bread bags
- newspaper sleeves
- dry cleaning bags
- bubble wrap
- plastic e-commerce mailers. (the soft plastic bags)

They are delivered to Trex Recycling and in return we receive a bench for the church upon reaching a certain poundage presented. It takes garbage out of the landfill and provides seating for our church landscape.

Plastics NOT recyclable include:

- Gift basket wrap
- Candy and potato chip bags
- Treat bags that are not stretchy
- Apple and grape bags
- Plastics that ARE recyclable include:
- #04 plastic bags
- Newspaper bags
- Grocery and drug store plastic bags
- Bubble wrap (any size, air okay in pockets)
- Air pillow packs (poke and squeeze air out)
- Cereal bags (turn inside out and shake)
- Bread bags (turn inside out and shake)
- Case overwraps (like for paper towels and bottled water)
- Zipper bags (if turned inside out, washed and dried)
- Stretchy plastic that you can push your thumb into without breaking
